





Strong passwords need to be memorable but not personal.

Looking at predictable passwords and creating new passwords of layered, random words will demonstrate how to set memorable but impersonal passwords.








There are 3 social media apps that characters from MONKEYCOW like to use:

- 3. PIGLY: for watching videos.


Take a look at each profile page then try to guess their password based on what the character likes a lot.

To reveal the passwords tap on to the password box and an arrow will appear.


